WHEREAS, the Elmira- Chemung Transportation Council (ECTC) has been designed by the Governor as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative planning process for the Elmira urbanized area, and

WHEREAS, Federal regulations (23 CFR Chapter 1, Part 450, Subpart C, and 49 CFR Chapter VI, Part 613, Subpart B) require that the urban transportation planning process shall include development of a Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) which shall annually describe all urban transportation and transportation related planning activities anticipated within the next one year period and will document the work performed with technical assistance provided under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), Division J, Title VII, and

WHEREAS, the ECTC UPWP provides a mutually agreed upon document which identifies the federally funded and local matched transportation planning activities to be undertaken in the MPO planning area during the program year, and

WHEREAS, the ECTC UPWP has been developed in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, and

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Elmira Chemung Transportation Council TIP Sub-Committee Committee hereby approves the attached SFY 2023-2024 Draft UPWP and be it further

WHEREAS, any project within the MPO Planning area utilizing federal funding with a change in funding over 10% or \$0.250 M must be amended in the TIP with the appropriate cost and schedule, and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to states through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to support eligible projects under American Rescue Plan (ARP) of 2021; and

WHEREAS, The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York to administer ARP for Federal formula small, urbanized areas (such as the Elmira urbanized area) and the Elmira-Chemung Transportation Council (ECTC) has agreed to NYSDOT administering the urbanized area ARP funds; and

WHEREAS, ECTC is the metropolitan planning organization responsible for programming Federal transportation funding for projects in the Elmira urbanized area, including FTA, ARP; and

WHEREAS, the ECTC FFY 2023 - 2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) needs to be amended to add the purchase of a County Staff Vehicle recommended to the Planning Committee by the ECTC,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Elmira Chemung Transportation Council Planning Committee hereby approves revision of the FFY 2023 - 2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to incorporate this new purchase, estimated at \$50,000., and be it further

RESOLVED, that this TIP revision be forwarded to the ECTC Policy Committee with a recommendation for their approval.
