GENERAL INFORMATION

AGE REQUIREMENTS & AGE CATEGORIES

The Chemung County Senior Games is open to anyone age 50 and older (by December 31st, 2023) for individual events. Eligibility for Softball events remains at age 65 and older (by January 31st, 2023). There is no fee for spectators. Family and friends are encouraged to attend any and all events to cheer on their athletes! Competition for some events is divided into the following age groups: **50-59, 60-69, 70-79, and 80+.** We will adjust age groups to ensure the athletes have competition. The average age of the doubles players will determine their age brackets.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

Participants are required to bring the appropriate equipment for the following events:

Archery: a bow and a minimum of 6 arrows (American 600 round)

Bowling: ball & shoes – can also rent at the alley **Golf:** clubs, golf balls and soft-spiked shoes

Pickleball: paddle **Please note: only** Senior Games equipment will be allowed for Softball Hit & Throw. Corn Hole and Miniature Golf.

FEES

The entry fee is \$10.00. **We do not provide refunds.** There is an additional charge for **Archery, Bowling, Golf, and the Field Day/Picnic.** Please see the registration form for costs. A \$5.00 fee will be added for the last minute day of event registrations.

AWARDS

Ribbons/Medals will be awarded to the top three finalists at each event according to age group and gender. The only exception is doubles bowling, doubles no tap bowling, doubles pickle ball and corn hole toss, which will be determined by the average of each team. No ribbons or medals will be awarded for the Field Day events.

TEAM SPORTS

For Softball & Team recreational volleyball, a player must be a member of a team. Individuals cannot apply to participate in a team sport. Recreational volleyball will allow mixed teams. Tournament format will be determined by the number of entries. Generally Central NYS Rules apply for softball. There must be a minimum of 4 teams in the division for a tournament to take place..

DOUBLES EVENTS

Doubles bowling, bean bag toss and pickleball will consist of mixed, men's, and/or women's teams. If you do not have a partner for these doubles sports, please indicate so on the registration form. There are no guarantees that a partner will be available to everyone. The age bracket is determined by the **average age** of the doubles players. Pickleball will be broken down by experience level as well as age. Both team members must be the same experience level.
