PROJECT OVERVIEW

Chemung County applied for and received federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding to create a bicycle-friendly corridor connecting two important economic regions in the community.

This project includes the creation of bicycle specific space and the installation of bicycle pavement markings and signage along the six-mile corridor that will provide cyclists with a defined route from Downtown Elmira to the Village of Horseheads.

The project location is a continuous six-mile corridor beginning on Davis Street at West Water Street in downtown Elmira and ending on Grand Central Avenue at West Broad Street in the Village of Horseheads.
