**Comments:** No violations observed during pre-operational inspection conducted in CCHD parking lot. Observed hand wash sink with warm water, soap, and paper towels. Advised staff that hands are to be washed after using the bathroom, eating, drinking, coughing, sneezing, in between glove changes, or whenever hands are contaminated. Advised staff to use digital probe thermometer, to ensure hot dogs (a potentially hazardous time/temperature controlled for safety food item) are cooked and hot held to 140F or greater. Observed homestyle refrigerator with monitoring thermometer to evaluate that unit is cold holding at 45F or less. Advised staff to work in small, manageable quantities and place any food not actively being prepared back into hot/cold holding. Facility has 20 gallon fresh water tank, with four 5-gallon water bottles, and a 25 gallon waste water tank, with a 20 gallon temporary waste water tank. Observed quaternary ammonia test strips, used to evaluate sanitizer in both 3 bay sink and wiping cloth bucket is 200 ppm. Advised staff to wash, rinse, and sanitize all food contact surfaces/utensils to prevent cross contamination.
