Big Flats Community Center (476 Maple St. Big Flats, 607-562-8443 Ext. 303) is a handicapped accessible, multi-purpose, multi-use facility intended for the use of Big Flats residents of all ages: youth, families and seniors. New programs are added daily.

Chemung County Family Fitness Center (425 Pennsylvania Ave. Elmira, 607-873-7177) provides a family-centered environment and includes programs and activities to promote a healthy lifestyle for children, adults and senior citizens.
