WHEREAS, The County is required under Federal Transit Administration regulations to annually set targets for its Federally-funded assets such as buses, large equipment, and its facilities for the next five years.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration intends to measure the performance of the system assets to see if they are in a State of Good Repair.

WHEREAS, Chemung County, working with First Transit, has performed an inventory and condition assessment of its buses, equipment, service vehicles and the two transit facilities (bus garage and Transportation Center).

WHEREAS, based upon the inventory and assessment, the Chemung County Legislature passed the following performance targets in April 2017:

- 25% of the buses may be at or exceed their useful life, 75% will be at an age less than their useful life
- 25% of all of the equipment and service vehicles may be at or exceed their useful life, 75% will be at an age less than its useful life
- 25% of the two transit facilities' components may be at condition rating 3/poor, 75% of the facility components will be rated better than condition rating of 3 out of 5.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Policy Committee recommends that the ECTC agree to accept and set Chemung County's targets for replacement of buses and equipment, and rehabilitation\replacement of facilities or facility components that are in poor condition for 2018-2022 as attached herein, and

RESOLVED, that this be forwarded to the various Federal and State agencies as required.
