RESOLUTION AWARDDING BID TO KIMBLE, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE CHEMUNG COUNTY NURSING FACILITY (RFB-2006 Nursing Facility Heater Project)

WHEREAS, sealed bids, pursuant to RFB-2006, were received and opened on January 12, 2018 for the Nursing Facility Heater Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Administrator for the Chemung County Nursing Facility ("CCNF") has recommended the acceptance of the lowest responsible bid meeting all bid specifications for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Buildings and Grounds Committee have reviewed the bid specifications, the bids submitted, the recommendations of the Administrator of the CCNF and LaBella Associates, DPC, the engineer for the Project, and they all recommend the Chemung County Legislature award the bid to the lowest responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for the Project, i.e., Kimble, Inc. ("Kimble"), at a cost of \$108,804 (base bid of \$106,604 plus Alternate 1 \$2,200) (\$54,402.00 Federal share, \$43,521.60 State share, \$10,880.40 local share) as more particularly described in the bid submitted by Kimble; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chemung County Legislature does hereby find that Kimble is the lowest, responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for the Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Kimble for the Project at a total cost of \$108,804 (base bid of \$106,604 plus Alternate 1 \$2,200) (\$54,402.00 Federal share, \$43,521.60 State share, \$10,880.40 local share) as more specifically set forth in the bid submitted by Kimble; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the terms and conditions of the agreement between the County of Chemung and Kimble shall be subject to the review and approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement authorized by this Resolution is contingent upon the receipt by the County of Chemung of the Federal and State funding in the amounts identified in the Preamble to this Resolution and in the event the County does not receive the Federal and State funding or there is a termination of the Federal or State funding for any reason the agreement authorized by this Resolution shall automatically terminate without further action by this Legislature; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement shall not be renewed, the initial term thereof extended, or the agreement amended without express consent by Resolution of this Legislature.
