RESOLUTION AWARDDING BID TO SILVERLINE CONSTRUCTION, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE CHEMUNG COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (RFB-2048 Bridge Replacement Projects - CR35 over Madison Creek, BIN 3331230 and BIN 3331240)

WHEREAS, sealed bids, pursuant to RFB-2048, were received and opened on November 8, 2018 for the Bridge Replacement Projects – CR 35 over Madison Creek, BIN 3331230 and BIN 3331240 (collectively the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Commissioner has recommended the acceptance of the lowest responsible bid meeting all bid specifications for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Highway Committee have reviewed the bid specifications, the bids submitted, the recommendations of the Public Works Commissioner and Hunt Engineers, Architects, Land Surveyors, and Landscape Architect, DPC, the engineers for the Project, and they all recommend the Chemung County Legislature award the bid to the lowest responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for the Project, i.e., Silverline Construction, Inc. (“Silverline”), at a cost of \$1,388,843 (80% Federal share, 15% State share, 5% local share) as more particularly described in the bid submitted by Silverline; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chemung County Legislature does hereby find that Silverline is the lowest, responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for the Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Silverline for the Project at a total cost of \$1,388,843 (80% Federal share, 15% State share, 5% local share) as more specifically set forth in the bid submitted by Silverline; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the terms and conditions of the agreement between the County of Chemung and Silverline shall be subject to the review and approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the bid award and agreement with Silverline are contingent upon the receipt of the Federal and State funding for the Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement shall not be renewed, the initial term thereof extended, or the agreement amended without express consent by Resolution of this Legislature.
