RESOLUTION AWARDDING BID TO AFT MECHANICAL, LLC ON BEHALF OF THE
CHEMUNG COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
(Justice Building HVAC Piping replacement Project Phase 2)

WHEREAS, pursuant to RFB-2076, sealed bids were received and opened on January 24, 2019 on behalf of the Chemung County Department of Buildings and Grounds for the Justice Building HVAC Piping Replacement Project, Phase 2 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Acting Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, and LaBella Associates, D.P.C. ("LaBella"), the Project Engineer, have reviewed the bid specifications and the bids submitted and they both recommend the acceptance of the bid received by AFT Mechanical, LLC ("AFT") in the amount of \$286,340.00 as the lowest responsible bid meeting all bid specifications for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Buildings and Grounds Committee have reviewed the bid specifications, the bids submitted, and the recommendation of the Acting Superintendent and LaBella, and they all recommend the Chemung County Legislature award the bid for the Project to AFT at a cost of \$286,340 having determined that AFT is the lowest responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for the Project; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chemung County Legislature does hereby find that AFT is the lowest responsible bidder meeting all bid specifications for Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with AFT for the Project at a total cost \$286,340 as more specifically set forth in the bids submitted by AFT; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the terms and conditions of the agreements between the County of Chemung and AFT shall be subject to the review and approval of the Attorney for the Districts; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreements shall not be amended without express consent by Resolution of this Legislature.
