### Activity Fee

\$125 - 1st child in the family \$100 - each additional child in the family

### Reduced Fee

\$65 - 1st child in the family \$50 - each additional child in the family

Eligibility for a reduced fee is determined by the total gross income and number of people listed on the 2018 Tax Return.

The tax return must list all children that will be registered.
